CONFERENCE REGISTRATION AND MEMBERSHIP PRICING FOR 2023

- Discussion about raising sponsorship pricing
 - o Pros:
 - Would help cover increasing costs
 - Other conferences are raising sponsorship pricing
 - o Cons:
 - Could discourage some sponsors
